### Abstract:

To what extent did bionanotechnology change the moral economy of science? In emphasizing the contrast of epistemic ideals of classical science and those of contemporary research in bio and nanotechnology, this talk will first characterize the epistemic virtues promoted by the community of synthetic biologists. Then it proceeds to consider the ethical issues raised by this epistemic culture and how they could be addressed.
